## **Directions:**

### **From the Mass Pike (Route 90):**

Take the Mass Pike (I-90) to Exit 10 Auburn. After toll booths, follow the signs for I-290 East. From I-290 Eastbound, take Exit 13 (Rte. 122A/Vernon St.) Turn left off the exit toward Kelly Square. Proceed through Kelly Square to Madison Street. (Hess gas station is on Madison St.) Proceed down Madison St. (0.4 miles) through two traffic lights. Go straight through second light onto Chandler St. proceed down Chandler St. to Queen St. Turn left onto Queen St. Go one block and take a right onto Jacques Ave.

## **Parking:**

Free parking is available in the lot one block up on the right. Go to the Thayer Building which is on the corner of Queen St. and Jacques Ave. enter the front of the building and take the stairway immediately to the left.
