From Route 90 East (The Mass Pike – Boston)

Take Route 90 (Mass Pike) West to Exit 10 (Auburn). After tollbooth, bear left at fork. Take Route 290 East. Get off at Exit 17. Take left at top of the ramp at set of lights. At second set of lights at bottom of hill make a left onto Major Taylor Boulevard. The hotel is on right.

From Route 495 (Foxboro, MA)

Take Route 495 North. Get off at Exit 25B. Take Route 290 West. Get off at Exit 18. Take right at end of the ramp and stay in left lane. Go straight through two sets of lights. The hotel is on right.

From Route 9 (Framingham)

Take Route 9 West all the way into Worcester. Cross Lake Quinsigamond Bridge. Four miles up road, Memorial Hospital is on right. At third set of lights, down the hill take left on to Major Taylor Boulevard. Hotel will be on right.

From Route 146 Providence (RI, Millbury & Sutton)

Take Route 146 North to Route 290 East. Get off at Exit 17. Take left at top of ramp at set of lights. At second set of lights take another left onto Major Taylor Boulevard. The hotel is on right.

From Route 90 West (Mass Pike, Springfield)

Take Route 290 East (Mass Pike) East to Exit 10 (Auburn). After tollbooth, bear left at fork. Take Route 290 East. Get off at Exit 17. Take left at top of the ramp at set of lights. At second set of lights take another left on Major Taylor Boulevard. The hotel is on right.
