**Holiday Inn Hotel

**FROM THE WEST:** Route 90 East (Mass Pike) to exit 10 (Route 290E). Take exit 20 (Burncoat/Lincoln St.). Go through first set of traffic lights. At second traffic light, turn left onto Lincoln St. (Route 70). The Holiday Inn is 1/2 mile on the left.

**FROM THE EAST:** Route 90 (Mass Pike) to Route 495 North to Route 290 West. Take Exit 20 (Burncoat/Lincoln St.), Turn right onto Lincoln Street. Holiday Inn in 1/2 mile on the left.
