Directions:

From the West (Springfield area):

Take Mass Pike East (Route 90 East) to exit 10 (Auburn). After toll booth, follow the signs for Route 290 East, take exit 20 (Burncoat/Lincoln St.). Go straight through first set of traffic lights. At second set of traffic lights turn left onto Lincoln St (Route 70). The Hotel is ½ mile on the left across from Lowes and Target Shopping plaza.

From the East (Boston area):

Take the Mass Pike (Route 90) West to exit 11A - Route 495, after toll booth follow the signs for Route 495 North. From Route 495 North follow the signs for Route 290 West. Off Route 290 West, take Exit 20 (Burncoat/Lincoln St). Turn right onto Lincoln Street, the Hotel will be approximately ½ mile on the left across from Lowes and Target Shopping plaza.
