Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery are Capital Investments!

The MA Bureau of Substance Abuse Services was allocated over \$47 million in state funding for FY '06. This represents about \$14 million in restoration from the original \$16 million cut. In the last two years, the state government passed about \$20 million from two supplemental budgets.

Note: A supplemental budget is state funding passed when there is a recognized void. This is a step towards healing from the devastation of lost lives to drug overdoses and diminished resources for recovery. We can never replace lost lives. We can plan to prevent further loss. A Strategic Plan is being implemented to put these dollars into effective use. Policymakers are getting the message from you, that prevention and treatment are capital investments. We are grateful to everyone strategizing together for healthy communities
