## Directions to the Italian American (“ITAM”) Lodge

From the big rotary at Park Square you will be forced to go right onto Bank Row.

Continue straight but get into the left lane and turn left onto First Street, which is Route 7, going north.

Continue on 7 north for about 2.5 miles, looking on the left for Hancock Road. (Traffic Light just before Pontoosuc Lake).

Turn left onto Hancock Rd. and go for about 0.4 of a mile.

Turn right onto Spaniol Rd. and go for less than a tenth of a mile.

Turn left onto Waubeek Road. The ITAM Lodge is at 93 Waubeek Rd., by Pontoosuc Lake. There is a large parking lot on the premises.
